Stage 1 Groundwork

Anatomy: Bony and muscular anatomy of the hand and forearm including surface anatomy

Hand Assessment: from initial consultation, goniometry and strength measurements

Wounds in hand therapy, Oedema management, Scar management Fractures & dislocations: Metacarpal fractures, PIP joint injuries, thumb MP joint injuries and fingertip injuries

Tendons - Extensors and intro to flexors, triggers, deQuervains **Common Hand Conditions** - CTS, Thumb OA & Dupuytrens

Stage 2 Growth

Anatomy: Wrist and forearm surface anatomy, tendon anatomy Assessment: Viewing XRays, assessing tendons, basics of wrist assessment Fractures: Finger fractures (P1, P2), thumb fractures

Wrist: Ganglions, distal radius fractures & Xrays, Management of DR#, scaphoid fractures

Tendons: Flexor tendon injuries, zones 1,2 then zones 3-5 thumb extensor injuries, and multiple extensor tendon injuries

Stage 3 Expand

Anatomy: Nerve anatomy, surface anatomy of the arm Assessment: Manual muscle testing, Sensory testing Fractures: Carpals, forearm & radial head fractures Wrist: The ulnar wrist -TFCC, ECU and central wrist ligament injuries Nerves: Compressions including cubital tunnel, radial tunnel then peripheral nerve repairs for median, ulnar and radial nerves

Stage 4 Flourish

Anatomy & Assessment of the elbow - bony, surface anatomy, elbow stability assessment

Fractures & Joints: Elbow fractures, humeral fractures, PIP joint arthroplasty **Complex**: Crush injury, infections, soft tissue reconstructions

Other Tendon problems: Distal biceps tendon injuries, Two stage FTR, Lateral elbow tendinopathy

About Cancellations

I know the risks and burden associated with putting on new staff or training someone in a new role. I know too that sometimes those new staff leave unexpectedly. It's tricky.

When you buy Seed you are committing to an investment in your business and your therapist. So what happens if you have to cancel Seed? I want to make it easier for you to make wise decision and juggle the budget, with a flexible cancellation policy.

- A full refund in the first month if you find Seed is not what you want or doesn't suit your practice.
- If cancellation occurs in the first 3 months the options are a pro rata refund.
- If your therapist leaves within the first 9 months, your program goes on hold. You have a licence for 3 years so you can restart the program with another therapist should you wish to do so.
- No refund is available on the setup fee but this can be transferred if your new therapist leaves in the first 3 months.
